ENROLLMENT

You are enrolled as a degree-program student at WU and will need to comply with WU rules and regulations.

ONLINE PRE-ENROLLMENT

In order to register as a student at WU, you need to complete the <u>online pre-enrollment</u>. You should have already received your individual nomination letter from your home university coordinator. This letter contains your WU student ID number & password as well as instructions on how to pre-enroll. Please do not forget to bring your nomination letter with you when you come to Vienna.

Please complete the online pre-enrollment by **November 30, 2021**.

The steps for the final enrollment will be explained in detail during the Welcome Days.

TUITION FEE WAIVER

You do not have to pay tuition fees at WU, but you do need to pay Students' Union (ÖH) dues each semester. Membership to the Austrian National Union of Students (ÖH) is compulsory for all students. The Students' Union (ÖH) dues cost approx. € 20.70 per semester.

Deadline for the payment of the Students' Union (ÖH) dues:

Summer semester 2022: April 30, 2022

Winter semester 2022/23: October 31, 2022

If you do not re-register (= pay the dues), your status as a student will expire and you will no longer be able to complete exams or courses.

You will receive further information on how to pay the Students' Union dues during the Welcome Days.

STUDYING AT WU - (PART I - PRE-ARRIVAL INFORMATION)

DOUBLE DEGREE CURRICULUM AT WU

You have to complete courses according to your double degree curriculum. Your WU MSc program coordinator will assist you in registering for the required courses at WU.

GERMAN BUSINESS COMMUNICATION COURSES

<u>German Business Communication courses</u> for exchange and double degree students are available during the semester at different skill levels, starting from beginner to very advanced. They are subject to a fee.

ECTS/ASSESSMENT

WU uses the European Credit Transfer System (ECTS) to assess and compare student workload. Each course is assigned a certain number of ECTS credits based on the student workload it involves.

PRE-SEMESTER ACTIVITIES

WELCOME DAYS

Our Welcome Days are intended for all incoming double degree and exchange students. The most important things you need to know about your studies at WU and your stay in Vienna will be explained there.

<u>Welcome Days & Enrollment 1</u>: February 3-4, 2022 (for students registered for any pre-semester programs)

Welcome Days & Enrollment 2: February 23-24, 2022 (for all other students)

Attendance at the Welcome Days at one of the two dates is mandatory. If you participate in the Orientation and Cultural Program and/or the pre-semester German language course, please attend the first Welcome Days & Enrollment. If you do not attend any of these pre-semester activities, please attend the second one.

ORIENTATION AND CULTURAL PROGRAM

The <u>Orientation and Cultural Program</u> offers newly arrived students the opportunity to learn more about Austrian culture while getting to know other double degree and exchange students on undergraduate and graduate level. The two-week program is held before the beginning of each semester and includes field trips in and around Vienna.

PRE-SEMESTER GERMAN LANGUAGE COURSE

In addition to the Orientation and Cultural Program, a two-week <u>pre-semester German language course</u> is available at different levels for incoming students. The Orientation and Cultural Program does not overlap with the pre-semester German language course, thus students can sign up for both.

Both the Orientation and Cultural Program and the pre-semester German language course are extracurricular, non-mandatory, two-week programs, which are subject to a fee and take place prior to the official semester start. Places are limited; make sure to register as soon as possible.

In order to register for the Orientation and Cultural Program and/or the pre-semester German language course, you have to create a WUNIVERSE account through the link below. Please use the e-mail address to which the welcome e-mail was sent for creating your WUNIVERSE account.

Please note: Once you complete your registration, the application is binding and the program/course fees are non-refundable. Cancellation is possible only in exceptional cases (withdrawal from the exchange program due to severe illness, unforeseen serious events).

ENTRY AND RESIDENCE REGULATIONS

Students from non-EU countries who stay in Austria for more than 6 months need a "residence permit – student" (*Aufenthaltsbewilligung Student*) for their residence in Austria. You can find detailed information on this process in the document "Info Sheet Residence Permit" attached to the welcome e-mail.

If you plan to stay in Austria for a shorter period, please read through the online information.

If you are a national of an EU/EEA country or Switzerland, you have to register with the MA 35 (Referat EWR) in Vienna if you are staying in Austria for longer than 3 months.

LIFE IN VIENNA

HOUSING

You are responsible for taking the appropriate steps to reserve and secure your own housing. Please have a look on our <u>Accommodation</u> website for further information on housing options in Vienna.

INSURANCE

EU-citizens must bring their European Health Insurance Card to prove health insurance coverage.

Non-EU citizens who need a residence permit are required to have Austrian health insurance. You can choose between the public insurance plan for students from the "Österreichische Gesundheitskasse" (<u>Selbstversicherung at ÖGK</u>) and private health insurance (e.g. <u>FeelSafe from Uniqa</u>). As you can sign up for your Austrian health insurance only after enrollment at WU you need to have a travel insurance for the first weeks of your stay in Austria. Please have a look on our <u>Health care and emergencies</u> website for more information.

It is your responsibility to make sure you have adequate health and travel insurance before leaving your home country.

BANK ACCOUNT

Student bank accounts, available to all exchange students, can be opened at almost any bank and are generally free of charge.

LEISURE AND SPORTS

You can register for sports classes offered by the University Sports Institute Vienna (USI Wien), which are available for students at a reduced rate. Several USI courses are held in the sport facilities on Campus.

You need your WU login data to register for the courses. Registration takes place on a first come, first served principle and you need to register for each course separately.

STUDYING AT WU - (PART II - AFTER ARRIVAL INFORMATION)

CREDIT TRANSFER PROCESS

All credits according to the first year of your studies at your home university need to be transferred and counted towards your WU degree. This will be done by the International Office.

Please make sure that your transcript displaying **all** required credits in your degree program gets sent by your home university to the International Office.

You will receive a final grade based on your grade average (weighted according to your credits), which will be displayed on your WU transcript for the subject "Double Degree Studies". The International Office will arrange for your grade to be entered into the system.

WU TRANSCRIPT OF RECORDS

If you need to, you can print out your preliminary transcript of records at the self-service terminals at the Study Service Center in building LC, level 2 or you can download it through the <u>online services for students</u>.

MASTER'S THESIS

You will be writing your master's thesis with the support of a WU supervisor and/or a supervisor from your home university according to the rules set by both institutions. Your MSc program coordinator will assist you with this process.

As soon as you have earned all the required credits in your degree program, you are required to upload your thesis to learn@wu (<u>https://learn.wu.ac.at/open/</u>). You are required to fill out a cover page electronically and include it at the beginning of the thesis document. Once you have uploaded your thesis + cover page to learn@wu, the thesis will be graded by your supervisor. You will see the grade in learn@wu and also be notified via e-mail.

Thesis evaluation can take up to two months.

You should start working on your thesis at the end of your first semester at WU (June). Double degree students are expected to finish their studies at WU within **one year**. This also includes the completion and grading of the master's thesis.

You need to complete your studies before **March 31, 2023** – this is the last day of your academic year at WU (Nachfrist). Only in exceptional cases and with the agreement of your home university, it is possible to prolong your studies. The latest possible day for your supervisor to enter your thesis grade into learn@wu is March 31, 2023. **Therefore, you are expected to submit your thesis by January 31, 2023 at the latest.**

COMPLETION OF YOUR STUDIES / GRADUATION DOCUMENTS

After completing all required courses and having received a grade for your master's thesis (all grades must be properly displayed in the online system), you must write an e-mail to the Examinations Office at <u>exam.master@wu.ac.at</u> to report the completion of your studies and submit a request for your graduation documents.

It is your responsibility to take this step. There will be no automatic notification or reminder to start this process.

Processing of graduation documents usually takes four weeks. You will be notified as soon as your graduation documents are available for pick-up in the Study Service Center/Examinations Office.

Even though you can apply via e-mail for completion of your studies, **your diploma can only be picked up in person**. Therefore, we advise to plan either to stay in or return to Vienna following the completion of your studies in order to retrieve your diploma. If you can't come in person, you need to appoint a proxy with a power of attorney to act on your behalf.

In order to pick up your graduation documents, you must bring the following documents:

- your WU student ID card or passport
- a **hardcover** copy of your master's thesis (will be available in WU's main library)
- a confirmation that you have completed the <u>UHstat2</u> form (either in digital form or as a print-out; UHstat2 is a survey by Statistics Austria)
- the last page of the <u>WU graduate survey</u> as confirmation that you have completed it (WU survey).

I The master's thesis has to be printed in **DIN A4 format**, preferably single-sided. The hardcover is usually black or dark blue. We recommend printing your master's thesis at <u>Facultas on Campus WU</u> as they are familiar with the format requirements.

GRADUATION CEREMONY

Once you have completed your studies, you are entitled to attend your WU MSc program's graduation ceremony. Each individual program holds a graduation ceremony for its own graduates.

At WU, graduation ceremonies are optional and do not necessarily take place within the same week or month in which you completed your degree requirements. When picking up the graduation documents, you will be asked if you would like to register for the official graduation ceremony. A fee of approx. \in 80 applies if you wish to participate. Payment of the fee by ATM card is required when signing up for the ceremony.

The graduation ceremony usually takes place in March. If you would like to participate you must have all your grades by the **end of January 2023**.

Participation is voluntary. You can complete your studies without attending the graduation ceremony.
