After earned my bachelor's degree in Economics from university and worked in financial field for some years. I gained the basic concept of business studies and realize the formal business education is essential at that point in helping to furnish my background with the necessary knowledge and tools required to lead a company to success. I was assigned to work as a finance controller at a subsidiary of our company in Brazil where I build up and supervised a finance team. Introduction of IESEG School of Management



IESEG School of Management was founded in Lille in 1964, and being a member of the Université Catholique de Lille, the Conférence des Écoles and the FESIC, IÉSEG School of Management is one of the best management schools in the world and is part of the very select circle of Schools that have been awarded the triple accreditation EQUIS, AACSB and AMBA. It is one of the top Business Schools in France, ranked 8th in France and 34th overall in the Financial Times master's in management 2021 ranking. From the international dimension, not only the programs are taught in English, but more than 80% of the permanent academic staff comes from abroad and more than 2,000 international students come to study on the School's campuses each year.

The school has two campuses, for the specialization I took was in Paris campus, which located in La Défense. (A major business district located 3 kilometers west of the city limits of Paris, approximately 20 mins away from the city center of Paris). Established primarily to strengthen IÉSEG's links with French and international companies, it has enhanced the institution's international reputation and visibility. As IÉSEG's reputation continues to grow along with its student population, the expansion of the Paris-La Défense campus in 2017 has enabled the school to welcome almost twice as many students as it could before. Composed of three buildings with a total of 16,500 m2 the campus offers students 20 lecture halls, 40 classrooms, three multimedia rooms, two trading rooms, a library, two cafeterias and meeting rooms for clubs and associations. Courses Structure at IESEG

I chose to take the specialization in Risk and Asset Management (Master of Science in Management) which belongs to Grande École Program. For first semester, it has 3 core courses (12 ECTS), 4 major core course (12 ECTS), 2 electives course (4 ECTS) and 1 language course (2 ECTS); and for the second and third semester, you will have to focus on the master thesis and executive internship. *I took another 6 electives (12 ECTS) in order to graduate within two years. (optional)

Basically, you have to pass all the course, thesis and internship to be eligible to get the degree which takes 2-3 semesters. Here's what I took during the year: (1 NCCU credit is the equivalent of 3 ECTS).
